






## THE GOSPEL COLORS


 **PURPLE**--Stands for the glory of God our King. We were created by our holy God to magnify His greatness. "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God." (1 Corinthians 10:31)


 **BLACK**--Represents our sin that separates us from a holy God. Because all of us have failed to glorify God by not honoring and obeying Him we deserve eternity in hell as God's judgment. "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23) "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

 **RED**--Stands for the blood of Christ. On the cross Christ died to take the place of sinners who would trust Him. "All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all." (Isaiah 53:6)

 **WHITE**--Speaks of a new heart. Every person that God calls to Himself receives a new heart that turns from sin and trusts Christ for the forgiveness of sin. "Repent then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out." (Acts 3:19)

 **BLUE**--Represents faith. God accepts sinful people when they put their trust in Christ alone for salvation. "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast." (Ephesians 2:8-9)

 **GREEN**--Pictures the new life we have in Christ. Everyone who comes to Christ will treasure Him above all things and desire to obey Him. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." (2 Corinthians 5:17)

 **YELLOW**--Stands for the kingdom of Heaven. God promises eternal life and joy for everyone who follows Jesus as their King. "Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world." (Matthew 25:34)
